Mommy and Me: Age 1 to 2 with participating adult

This class focuses on what toddlers like the best: music, playing and close attention from mommy or daddy. Babies will develop an ear for the languages being spoken and pick up sounds in the target language. Parents will be learning songs and words to be used at home.

Immersion Preschool: Age 3 to 5

Our European-Style Immersion Preschool is perfect as a first experience preschool or as a 2 or 3 day supplement to your child's English preschool. Our immersion preschool follows a format similar to English preschool, with many of the same routines and activities but with a heavy emphasis on the language building activities (song, rhyme, repetition, dance and movement). No need to worry that your child may get confused, over time, they won't! Our immersion approach means that every moment in the classroom is also considered for its language-learning opportunities.

Conversation A & B: Grade school age with up to 1 year background

Conversation A level is designed for both students who want to try out a foreign language class and for those who may be serious about becoming fluent and literate. This level is part our immersion program so the class is taught 100% in the target language. It also follows a curriculum that is articulated with our Conversation B, Bridges and Literacy level. Student will have the strong language listening comprehension skills necessary to excel in the next level.

Conversation B level requires 1 year background in the language. Conversations and dialogs are extended through role-play, skits and class routines. Workbooks are used to develop literacy and homework is given.

Bridges 1 to 3: Kinder & Grade School with 2 or more year of language

These classes are for children who started learning the foreign language at an earlier age. These classes follow the natural process of language acquisition. In Bridges 1 (Kindergarten) no direct reading or writing will be involved. In level 2 to 4 strong conversation skills and deeper understand of the language will be developed as literacy will be gently introduced in preparation of our literacy levels. Homework is given. Children might be tested to enter our bridges classes.

Literacy: Grade school and middle school with prior experience

These classes are designed for the students who went thru our bridges levels or have similar experience in the language. In these ore advances levels, conversation skills continue to improve while literacy is being developed. Homework will be given. The 5 levels of literacy cover the grammar and writing equivalent to the first 2 years of high school. Students might be tested to enter our Literacy classes.
